Dear Parents/Carers,

Sports Day

A reminder that next Friday is our sports day. We sent a letter last week with more information about sports day. Please be aware that if you require a school sandwich lunch, you must return the slip at the bottom of this letter by Monday morning or your child will not have a lunch provided by school. Children must wear their plain team colour PE t-shirt with plain blue shorts and plimsoles. They must bring a sunhat and water bottle to school. Children do not need to bring their bookbag for sports day.

Sports day starts at 10.30am and all children will be involved throughout. Sports day will then finish at around 12.00 and you are then welcome to use our field for a family picnic. Children may return to their class at 1.00pm for the rest of the day however you are free to take your children home after the picnic. The gates will open at 10:15am for you to find a space.

We would ask that during the sports day, if your child becomes upset then please leave them for staff to comfort them, if we need your help we will come and speak to you. We will be relying on you to cheer the children on throughout sports day!

Please be aware that Nursery will have their own sports day and I will write to you early next week with more information about this.


