Moments Matter, Attendance Counts

Firstly, a little reminder that if your child is unwell and will not be in school you must telephone the school office to let us know. Please do not message staff using Seesaw.

I am sure that you will have noticed the increased press around attendance. The government have recently launched a national campaign to improve attendance. 40 of children who are persistently absent (absent more than 10% or have attendance below 90%) reached expected level in Year 6 compared to 84% of children who attend regularly.

The chief medical officer and the NHS say that it is usually appropriate for children to come to school with a mild respiratory illness and general cold symptoms e.g. a cough, runny nose or sore throat.

We always take a 'support first' approach when it comes to attendance so if you need support please speak to the school office.

Roof Update

The roof work is starting in earnest next week. After so much planning and preparation it is good to see that work will finally be starting and we will keep you posted with how it is going.

Curriculum Sessions
