#### **Behaviour Curriculum**

Over the last few months, I have been busy working with Mrs Pipe (the headteacher of Parkgate Junior School) to create our behaviour curriculum.

The behaviour curriculum sets out our expectations for how children should behave at Parkgate Infants and Nursery and Parkgate Junior School– we call this the 'Parkgate Way'. It also sets out an expectation that positive behaviour should **taught to** children.

Our behaviour curriculum includes how children sit in assembly and in the classroom, how children should line up and how children are expected to behave at lunchtime.

We also include our expectations around uniform which I have included below:

## Uniform

- Only stud earrings can be worn in school.
- No jewellery can be worn, except for religious observance.
- 4. No nail varnish.
