Welcome to Parkgate Nursery, we hope that it will be an exciting year.

Firstly, just a few reminders of what is expected at nursery. No jewellery at all for health and safety reasons. We encourage children to be independent in using the toilet but, of course, we do appreciate that accidents happen. Your child will NOT need a water bottle or a snack. Healthy snacks are provided on a daily basis, with a choice of milk or water. If your child has any allergies please let us know.

A few other activities we would encourage you to practice at home with your child are:

- Going to the toilet and washing own hands
- Putting on and doing up own shoes.
- Putting on own coat/ hat/ gloves etc.
- Using scissors/ pencils/ crayons etc.

On Fridays the children will have an opportunity to use the library bus and choose their own book, with adult support. Visiting your local library with your child is an activity that is encouraged and will help to prepare them for visits to the school library bus.

Once the children are all happy and settled into nursery, one child per week will have an opportunity to take home our class soft toy (Derek the duck). They can play with Derek over the weekend and return him on Monday. In the bag there is a book where your child can draw a picture of what they did with Derek.

Lastly, please do remember to label all items of clothing as things do inevitably get mixed up! This should include shoes as well, if possible.
