## Maths

This week the children have been learning the days of the week.

Ask the children each day what day it is, what day was it yesterday and what day will it be tomorrow to enforce their learning.

Make a chart as to what the children do on certain days of the week.



## English

This week the children have been learning to talk about their favourite foods. They have been drawing them and beginning to write the initial sound of the words.

In line with maths we have been trying to get the children to recognise the days of the week.

Please continue to read with your child every day and write this in their yellow book. Remember to practice the word lists at the back on the yellow book.

## Other News

In phonics this week the children have learnt the sounds /t/ and /p/. Ask your child to identify these in their reading books. And begin to blend simple words using these sounds such as 'sat', 'pat', 'tap' and 'sap'.
