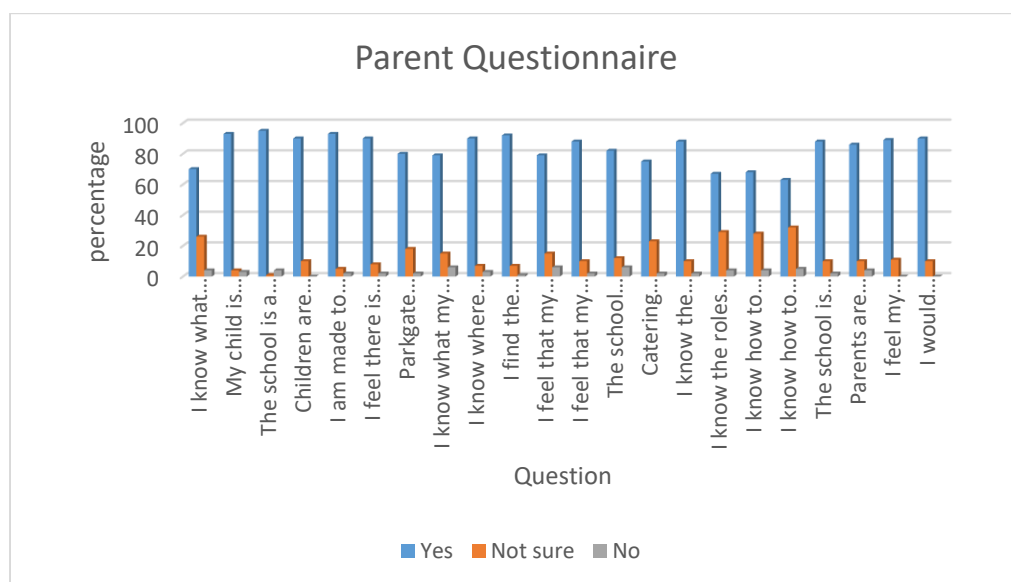


Results of the Parent Questionnaire 2017

- Pathway to be wider
