

## Year 2 – Meet the Teacher



- The teachers are Miss Annal (Fox class) and Mrs Siebu (Badger class).
- TAs are Mrs Ryan, Miss Hunt and Mrs Buckley. Please give any notices to TAs in the morning and arrange to have a telephone appointment.
- PE kits should be kept in school and should include plain blue shorts, team colour t-shirt and plimsolls.
- Please provide spare socks for girls if they are wearing tights.
- Please label all school uniform, PE kit and the PE bag itself (including hats, plimsolls, coats).
- No jewellery should be worn except earrings (flat – not studs).
- Book bags need to be in school every day – please read every night and record in reading record book.
- Water bottles need to be in school every day – can be in team colour which can be purchased from the office.
- Recorders need to come into school on a Thursday – please practise at home.
- This year we are having maths homework. Maths homework books go home on a Friday and must be returned by Wednesday – please only use 1 page per week. There are additional ideas of activities you could do with your child on the back of the curriculum booklet. These do not need to be handed in but you can share them with us if you like. They won't be marked. A more detailed letter will be going home today to explain how homework will work this year.
- Spellings go home on a Friday and must be handed in on a Wednesday ready to be tested. Please practise these at home with your child.
- Golden time is on a Thursday afternoon. This includes Game On, library and recorders. Library books will need to be sent in on Thursday so that children can return books and choose new ones.
- We are sending home a copy of the TAFs (Teacher Assessment Framework) – these show you what is expected of your child at the **end of year 2**.
- There will be a SATs meeting on later on in the year. Please note that 'tests' are followed by teacher assessment and we don't make it explicit to the children that they are doing tests.
