I would like to firstly thank those parents who have been supporting us whilst we are managing an outbreak of COVID in school.

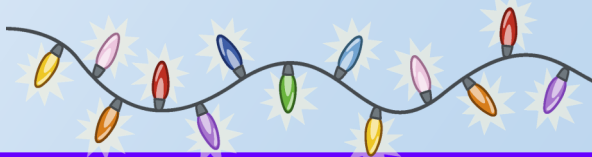
We know that this is a concerning time and would like to reassure parents that we have a number of measures in school to prevent the spread of illness through the school.

All parent are encouraged to continue with the twice weekly lateral flow testing, as staff are doing.

As with most areas, everything is very much subject to change depending on COVID measures in school at the time e.g. whilst we are intending for plays to take place in person, please be aware these may need to be recorded as we did last year.
