Choose one family learning activity each week. You can choose which one to do and in which order you do them. For when you have a busy weekend we have included a Family week. These are suggestions of things which you might do and there is no need to record anything in your homework book for the family week, unless you wish to. Homework books must be in school on Wednesday. **Please use only one page per week, look after your book and always do your best work.**

<p><u>Maths</u> Find different ways to make 10 using 2 single digit numbers. You can your answers with drawings or in number sentences e.g. $0000+000000=10$ or $4+6=10$s Challenge: Can you add three single digit numbers to make 10? E.g. $3+5+2=10$</p> <p>Signature of Teacher:</p>	<p><u>PSHE</u> Write about what makes you special and what you are good at. Think about how you are different to your classmates.
