

## Family Learning: Year 2

Choose a family learning activity each week. You can choose which one to do and in which order you do them. For when you have a busy weekend we have included a Family week. These are suggestions of things which you might do and there is no need to record anything in your homework book for the family week, unless you wish to. Homework books must be in school on Wednesday. Please use only one page per week, look after your book and always do your best work.

<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Pick your favourite story book and write a book review on it. In your book review include a short summary of the story itself, what you liked about it, who your favourite characters are and your favourite part of the book.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Write down 3 or 4 sentences recommending this book to your teacher. You must make them want to read this book.</p> <p>Signature of Teacher:</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Create a tally chart of the different colour cars you see in a set time (about 10 minutes would be suitable).</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Write two sentences to show which colour car is the most popular and which is the least popular.</p> <p>Signature of Teacher:</p>	
<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Find a book of your choice and draw an illustration for the title page. Add lots of colour and detail to your illustration.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Go to the library and look at different illustrators. Pick your favourite illustrator and write down 2 or 3 sentences explaining why they are your favourite.</p> <p>Signature of Teacher:</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Design a poster to show people ways to help our planet. Some ideas could include: saving electricity, saving water, recycling and walking instead of driving.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Find 3 facts about Climate Change that will help you to persuade people.</p> <p>Signature of Teacher:</p>	<p><u>Family Week</u></p> <p>For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- a walk in the woods</li><li>- we acted out a story</li><li>- we went to a museum</li></ul> <p>Or</p> <p>Family Week</p> <p>This is free for whatever lovely activity you choose to do together one weekend.</p> <p>Signature of Teacher:</p>
